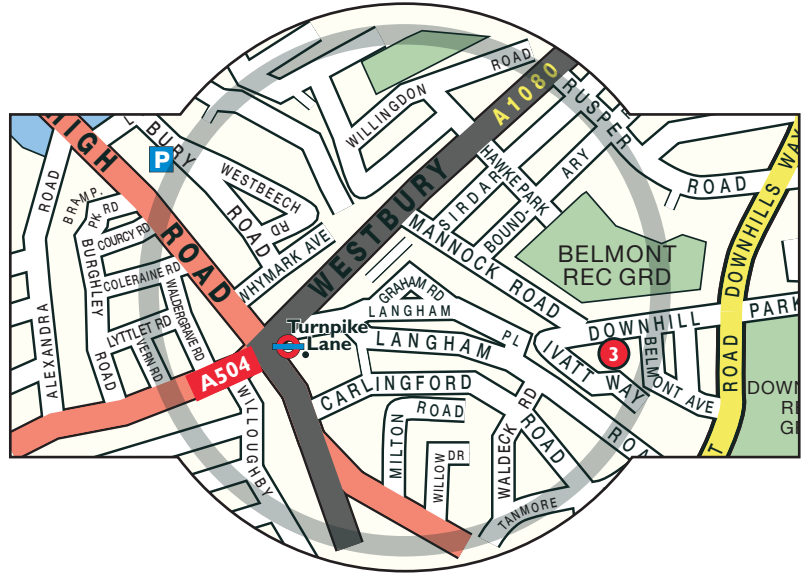
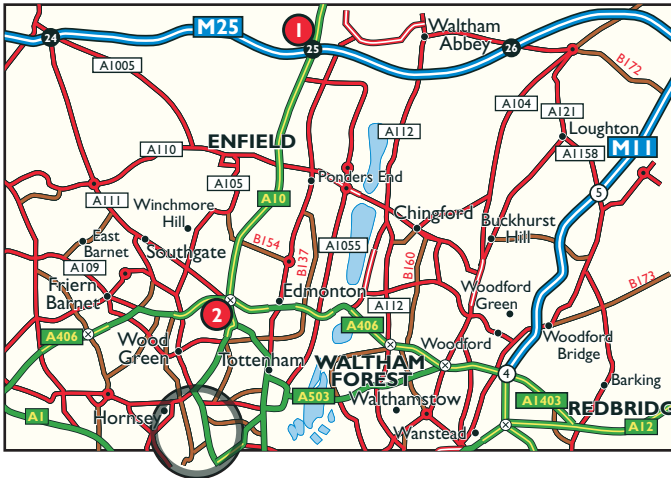

## By car

- 1** From M25  
Take Junction 25 towards Enfield (A10)
- 2** From North Circular (A406)  
Take the A10 south from North Circular for one mile, then fork right for West End (A400); go straight on at Lordship Lane traffic lights; right at mini roundabout after speed bumps
- 3** PDC is on the left as road bends right (car park at rear).

## By public transport

PDC is a five minute walk from Turnpike Lane Underground station (Piccadilly Line, many buses)

Walk along Langham Road (past First Choice furniture store on your left), Graham Road, Langham Place through walkway to Downhills Park Road.
