



APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Initial Application

- *Complete this initial application form and return it with payment by 17 September 2007 to request places on behalf of your school/college and designate a coordinating teacher.*

2. Response from the Holocaust Educational Trust

- *Upon receipt of applications, the Holocaust Educational Trust will allocate places for student participants on a first-come first-served basis and contact coordinating teachers by email to confirm participation.*
- *Teacher places will be allocated after student places have been filled, depending on space availability.*
- *Please be aware that space is limited – particularly for teacher places – and not all applicants will necessarily be offered places. In many cases, schools may be offered places for students but not for a teacher.*
- *Students and teachers whose applications are not initially accepted will be placed on a reserve list, and may be notified at a later date if space becomes available.*

3. Online Registration

- *Once notified by email, the coordinating teacher must submit the names and contact details of participants via the LFA Project online registration system (log-in details to the system will be provided in the confirmation email).*
- *These designated participants will then receive their own log-in details enabling them to access online application and medical forms, which need to be completed, signed, and returned by post to the Holocaust Educational Trust prior to the Orientation Seminar.*
- *Any outstanding payment balance is also due at this time.*

NB: For travel to Poland, all participants are required to have at least six months validity on their passport on the day of the visit.
