Daniel first came into contact with Armonía during his teens when he was supported as he grieved the death of his younger brother (who tragically died whilst working on the streets). Dani became involved in the work of Armonía, became a Christian and was one of the first Armonía University Scholarship recipients. He is now a lawyer, and works for Armonía, co-ordinating projects and mentoring young people. He is currently seeking more graduate training.

"When I first had contact with Armonía they offered me a scholarship to continue with my studies, because I was in an emotional crisis. The scholarship in that moment was the only opportunity to rescue my life, continue with my studies and was a small solution to help my family financially. With this scholarship I did my High School studies and later my Law degree. I can now understand that this scholarship doesn't only have the goal of financial support but it also works as an instrument that forms youth who seek a better quality of life and who are urgently needing to know God and to have a relationship with Him. The most beautiful thing that I can tell you in this moment is that I am part of a ministry that has made a commitment to help me in every moment, and that offers me a great family in Christ, as well as offering me the opportunity to serve others who are in similar situations to the one that I was in years ago."

The Vision

The Armonía scholarship program is far more than monetary support. Armonía provides the students with challenges and training in management and strategic thinking and gives them the tools for acting in compassion towards those in need, mainly those from their communities of origin. Combined with an education in their chosen field, and active participation in the strategically located Community Transformation Centres in Mexico City, each University student commits to 3 years of service in their region, allowing this training to become a powerful force for transformation.

Who does Armonía give Scholarships to?

Recipients are chosen carefully, with particular attention paid to the student's attitude towards work and study, as well as their financial situation. Many come from the very poor remote and scattered villages to the Armonía Students' Residence to get their Junior High School and A-Level educations. Others come from the Armonía communities in Mexico City or Oaxaca where Armonía runs Transformation Centres. Those who succeed in their studies, and apply for the Armonía Scholarship must demonstrate a commitment to hard work and continue to work and train with Armonía alongside completing their studies.

How much does it cost to sponsor a student?

To support a young person through University it costs £120 per month. However, you don't have to raise the amounts in full in order to support the scheme. An individual can give any regular monthly amount towards this cost, or groups together can raise enough to support one student. For example, 8 people each committing to give £15 per month together can support one University student. As an individual you can contribute in part or in full to the costs of sponsoring a student. If you agree to receive information from us, you will hear from time to time the latest general updates about the students' progress, and the other work Armonía is doing. All scholarship funding is administered through a general fund for the students according to their continuous commitment to the agreed goals. As such, you would be contributing to a general fund, rather than your donation specifically attaching to one student.
