### What? Why? How? When?

#### What is the School Council?

An inclusive, structured, forum for discussion and decision-making

A means for children to raise issues and concerns

A means to consult all pupils

#### Why have a School Council?

To help children develop responsible attitudes

To improve behaviour

To give children hands-on experience of issues in the National Curriculum, including PHSE and Citizenship

To create a feeling of belonging, encourage listening to others and develop self-confidence

To improve pupil/teacher relationships

#### How does the School Council work?

The Chair leads the meetings

Conventional committee procedures are used

Class representatives bring issues to the School Council

#### When does the School Council take place?

Usually every week, on a Friday, at 12:30 pm.
