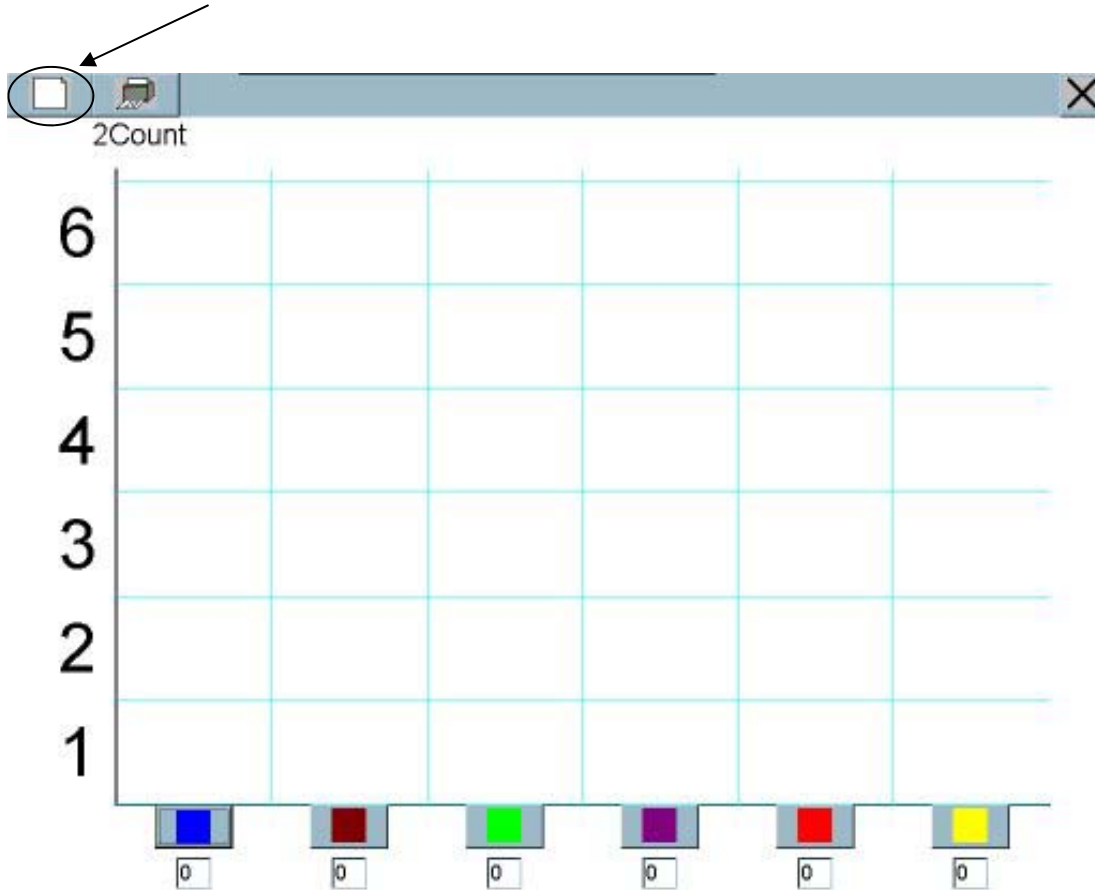




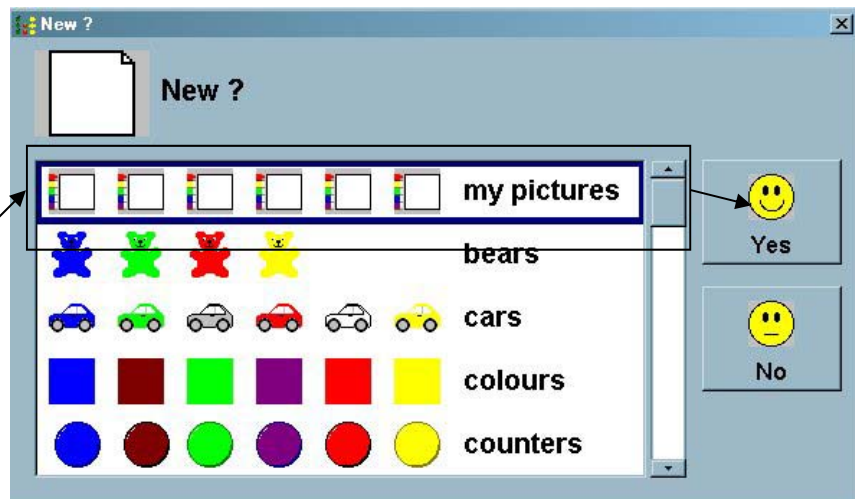
Adding My Pictures to 2Count

2Count by default opens giving colours as the options for the pictogram. However if these are not the colours you wish to be represented, or the images you want are not listed then complete the following steps.

1) Click on the 'New' icon.



2) From the 'New' dialogue box select 'my pictures' and then click on 'Yes'.



3) From this dialogue box there are now several things you can do....

Reduce the number of pictures given as options.

Select the picture you want to change by making sure the blue box is around it.

You can use the pens to colour in the large square to display the colour you wish to be shown.

Or you can click on the 'Open' icon to find an image which you may have saved from the internet or created in a graphics package.

4) When you have made all the changes you require click on the 'Yes' icon.



5) The images you have imported or created can be saved by saving the pictogram. To display the save and open icons use **ctrl+shift+o** and tick the option to show icons on toolbar.
