



Mystery Alphabet

Objectives:

- Recognise and create complete sentences
- Expand sentences using adjectives and adverbs.
- Recognise parts of speech
- Recognise and use number patterns

Lesson:

1. Create a "mystery alphabet" using numbers for letters and publish it for pupils on an overhead, whiteboard or handout. (Example: 1 = A, 2= B, etc.)
2. Have pupils create a paragraph of at least three sentences using only numbers and include at least one adjective and adverb in each sentence.
3. Exchange AlphaSmarts or Danas and have pupils write out the sentences using the number code as a guide. Read paragraphs aloud to verify correct content.
4. To expand this activity, have pupils generate their own "mystery alphabets" using another number pattern (example 2= A, 4= B, 6=C)
5. Exchange AlphaSmarts/Danas, figure out the number pattern and write the sentences using words instead of numbers. Print and read aloud.
