

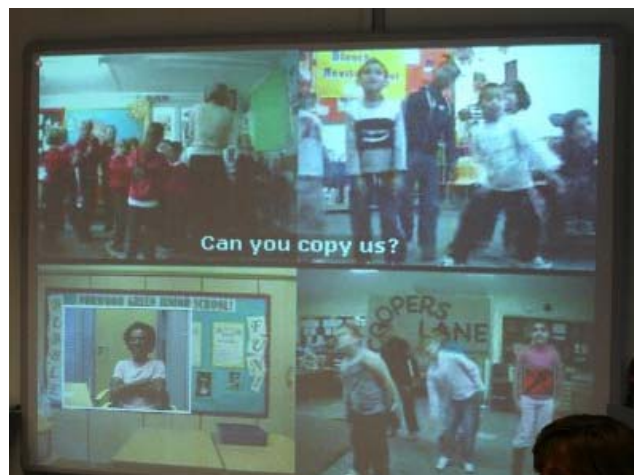
Pan U.K. Primary Video Conference for Deaf Pupils , *Tell Me A Story*: 26th March 2007

The morning of 14th of November 2006 saw a special video conferencing event for deaf children in primary schools in London hosted by LGFL and supported by The National Deaf Children's Society. The event, chaired by Ahmed Mudawi, was a great success. At 1 point ,44 classes were watching through the internet and 6 via video conference units.



On March 26th 2007, we would like to host an event for primary pupils on the theme of Tell Me A Story. Pupils from different schools can present fictional or non-fictional stories (through role play, song, puppet theatre) or can teach the other pupils something. We will be able to incorporate presentations from six schools, with at least 2 KS1 classes involved.

You will only need a computer and internet access to watch the event, but you can watch and ask questions through your video conferencing unit if you have one. Pupils and teachers will be able to ask questions through text and e-mail on the day if they don't have video conference units
